NO.4 INDEPENDENT COY. 5 TROOP NO.2 COMMANDO

<u>ARTHUR ASHCROFT</u>	With 4 Ind.Coy. in Norway. Wounded at St. Nazaire and P.W.W.
<u>E. DOUGLAS</u>	With 4 Ind.Coy. in Norway; escaped from France after St.Nazaire raid and awarded MM.
<u>JOHN GWYNNE</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway. Murdered whilst P.O.W. at St.Nazaire.
<u>PETER HONEY</u>	4 Ind. Coy. in Norway. P.O.W.St.Nazaire and awarded MM.
<u>BOB LOWSON</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway. Went on detachment with Commandos in Middle East; joined S.A.S. and awarded MM after service in Europe.
<u>KEN McALLISTER</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway: remained with 5 Troop 2 Cdo. throughout the war and finished up as CSM.
<u>DON RANDALL</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway. P.O.W. St.Nazaire and awarded DCM.
<u>ALAN MOSS</u>	4 Ind.Coy.in Norway; became first RSM of 2 Commando; was killed at St.Nazaire and would most certainly have been highly decorated if he had lived. M.I.D. St.Nazaire.
<u>COLIN JONES Sgt.</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway. P.O.W. St.Nazaire and awarded MM.
<u>LEN PERKINS</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway: remained with 2 Commando throughout war and finished as CSM. Was awarded MM and M.I.D. in Italy.
<u>CAPT.DONALD ROY</u>	4 Ind. Coy. in Norway. Captain 5 Troop 2 Commando. P.O.W.St.Nazaire. Awarded the D.S.O.
<u>CAPT.LARRY TAYLOR</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway. Became Captain 5 Troop 2 Commando after service in M.E. and Italy and Yugo-Slavia.
<u>LT.JOHN PROCTOR</u>	4 Ind.Coy. Norway. Seriously wounded at St.Nazaire.
<u>CAPT.A.B.J.HOUGHTON</u>	Norway, St.Nazaire. Was executed by Germans after Glomfiord Raid in 1942.
<u>TOM McCORMACK</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway. P.O.W. St.Nazaire: died of wounds received.
<u>LES WHELAN</u>	4 Ind.Coy.in Norway. P.O.W. St.Nazaire raid.
<u>BILL HUGHES</u>	Norway, Vaagso Raid: P.O.W.St.Nazaire.
<u>BILL STALKER</u>	4 Ind.Coy. in Norway. Went on detachment with Commando then joined S.A.S. and served in Europe with them.
<u>J.G.ROGERS</u>	4 Ind.Coy. St.Nazaire, Sicily, Italy, Yugo-Slavia and Albania. Awarded MM in Albania.
