He has been in the Forces since the commencement of the war. Many friends remember his little son, Peter, who has just had two serious operations on his legs. Peter has spent many years of his short life in hospitals, but we are pleased to say these operations have been most successful and Peter will be able to walk much better. He still attends Luton Hospital daily for special walking exercises.
