ONE OF HER SEVEN SONS KILLED

Official intimation has been received by Mrs. Sarah Gallagher, of 7, Malden-street, Leyland, that



her fourth son, Private Denis Gallagher, of the Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders, was killed on active service.

Pte. Gallagher who was 27, joined the Army in June last year. He was educated in Scotland and came to Leyland about 10 years ago.

Until he joined the Army he was employed at a North-West Munitions Factory.

Three of Mrs. Gallagher's seven sons are serving in the Army and another in the Navy.
