Commando S. S., has been killed in action in Italy. Sergeant Dundas was thirty years of age. He joined the Black Watch in 1934, and prior to the war he served in India and Palestine. He volunteered for the Commandos on their inception, and had taken part in many daring raids. His commanding officer writes: "He was a true and trustworthy N.C.O. who will be sorely missed." He was married last August to a Kirkcudbright lady who still resides there.
