Invasion veteran dies, aged 70

NORMANDY veteran Clifford Grace has died suddenly at the age of 70 years.

A former member of the Royal Marine Commandos first special service brigade the Waltham Cross resident took part in the allied



invasion of Europe on D-Day June 6, 1944.

He had also carried out a lot of secret work in preparation for the invasion.

He revisited the scenes of the second world war battles every year.

A member of Hoddesdon's Normandy Veterans' Association and the Commando Association Mr Grace, of Leven Drive, is a former butcher and bank security worker.

He leaves five children, 12 grandchildren and one great grandchild.

The funeral took place on Wednesday at Enfield Crematorium.
