A former member of the Stirlingshire Constabulary, whose early service was at Causewayhead Police Station, Cpl. George Robertson, Royal Marine Commandos, has died of wounds received in action. His father, Mr George Robertson, lives at Rawhills, Douglas Water, Lanarkshire. Twenty-six years of age, Cpl. Robertson joined the police force in April, 1937, and after being stationed at Causewayhead was transferred to the Burgh of Falkirk, where he remained until he joined the Marines in August, 1942. When in Falkirk he was well-known as an athlete of more than usual ability. He was a prominent member of the Stirlingshire Police football team, and the intimation of his death has caused much genuine regret among his colleagues throughout the county and in the Eastern District in particular. Since joining the Marines he married a Cumberland lady.
